From the playwright

While researching this play, I spoke to sanitation workers from New York to Colorado to Pennsylvania. A theme that came up repeatedly was invisibility; they felt invisible in uniform. I heard stories of people letting their dog pee on a bag as a garbage collector bent over to retrieve it, or a pedestrian hocking a loogie into a corner basket as a worker emptied it into the truck's hopper.

In the early months of the pandemic, New Yorkers opened their windows at 7pm each night to cheer for health care workers. No one cheered for sanitation. Yet, the on-the-job injury and fatality rates consistently rank sanitation among the most dangerous jobs in the country, and without the dedicated, systematic, and continuous efforts of these essential workers, our neighborhoods would quickly become unlivable.

This theme of invisibility became a guiding principle of the play. From the jump, both Danny and Marlowe have very specific opinions about how they want to be seen; at the same time, they're unable to see each other clearly. Making strangers less strange is my primary mission as a storyteller. Listen...this world gets weirder by the day. Learning to see someone else on their own terms—and summoning the grace to see ourselves in the other—feels more essential now than ever.


