





FROM THE PLAYWRIGHT

So, in the summer of 1987, a few months after graduating high school and a few months before leaving to start at the theatre conservatory at the University of Illinois, I went to see Wallace Shawn's Aunt Dan and Lemon at Steppenwolf in Chicago. I remember arriving at the theatre. Remember finding my seat. The lights went down and then...well... something just happened. The cast – under the direction of Frank Galati – performed a piece of theatre that felt less like theatre and more like life. Dangerous, interesting, moving, funny, challenging, life. The actors just sort of existed, raw and honest in front of me. And afterwards, I couldn't shake it. On the way home. The next morning. The experience was indelible. And it was THIS experience that was in my head when I sat down to write FEVER DREAMS. I was hoping to create a play... for actors... a director... designers... and – mostly – for an audience that might also resemble dangerous, interesting, moving, funny, challenging, life.

I don't want to say much more than that. Part of the joy (at least for me) about going to see plays are the surprises. So, I won't spoil them.

And then I'll close by saying, thank you...for being here...for sustaining theatre...for being witness to (and in that way collaborating in) this small piece of dangerous, interesting, moving, funny, challenging, life.
